

### Sample Triage Survivor Injury Cards

These cards are intended to simplify the process of creating volunteer survivors. Use these descriptions to create roles for the volunteers. Brief them on the nature of their injuries, how they might behave, and any information you want them to share with SAR staff.

<p><b>SURVIVOR 1</b></p> <p>Large piece of wood in left thigh Breathing once every 3 seconds Color returns to finger tips in less than 2 seconds Alert</p>	<p><b>SURVIVOR 2</b></p> <p>Severe cut on right thigh, heavy bleeding Breathing once every 5 seconds Knows name, date, and what happened Color returns to finger tips in 3 seconds</p>
<p><b>SURVIVOR 3</b></p> <p>Back injury, unable to move Breathing once every 4 seconds Knows name, date, and what happened Color returns to finger tips in 2 seconds</p>	<p><b>SURVIVOR 4</b></p> <p>Severe bleeding from head wound Breathing once every 2 seconds Not responsive to questions Color returns to finger tips in 4 seconds</p>
<p><b>SURVIVOR 5</b></p> <p>Impaled object in abdomen; breathing difficulties Breathing once every 3 seconds Can't remember what happened Color returns to finger tips in 5 seconds</p>
